Under the legendary Piero Antinori, and his three daughters, the family continues to produce high class wines using traditional grape varieties, allied to modern techniques. The daughters became the 26th generation of winemaking within the family.

Cipresseto shows a delightful mid-pink colour, aromas of plums and berry fruit, and an attractive crisp, refreshing finish.

One of Sicily's very best estates produces this first class wine from the native Sicilian red grape, Nero d'Avola. Dark, dense and full of flavour with a silky finish from an historic, noble estate established in 1950. The wine is seen in very fine Italian restaurants in this country and around the world. The winery also houses one of Italy's best cookery schools founded by the late Anna Tasca Lanza who wrote the definitive books on the cuisine of the island, *The Heart of Sicily* and *The Flavours of Sicily*. The estate has been awarded 'Italian Winery of the Year 2012' by Gambero Rosso, Italy's most respected wine guide.
